RE: Summer Programming Grades 1-8

A summer learning program addressing Math and English/Language Arts will begin Monday, June 7. The on-site program will run Monday through Thursday from 9:00-12:00 for four weeks. The last day of this summer program will be Thursday, July 1.

Participating students will have the opportunity to receive breakfast on site and will be able to take lunch in a grab-and-go fashion. Transportation will be provided by HPS if necessary.

The program will be monitored and supported by HPS Teachers and Paraprofessionals. The platform that will be used is Edgenuity, which will foster a learning environment that incorporates both face-to-face and virtual connection. Grade 1-5 students will be utilizing Edgenuity's "MyPath" platform. Students in grades 6-8 will be enrolled in Math and English/Language Arts prep for the next school year.

In order to adequately staff this endeavor, we are asking parents to commit to participating in this enrichment program and letting the school know as soon as possible via email or phone call. Schools must be notified by Friday, May 21. (See contact information at the end of this letter.)

We expect that if students are enrolled in this opportunity they will:

- Attend face to face and participate in activities related to learning through the length of the program.
- Be prepared to be challenged and be ready to learn each and every day.
- Maintain 90% attendance.
- Exhibit positive learning and listening behaviors.

Students must have prior enrollment in Havre Public Schools to participate in the summer learning program. This opportunity is only for students currently enrolled in grades K-7 who will be 1st-8th graders in school year 2021-2022.

As we receive requests to engage in this opportunity, more information will be provided on the school's website, including the location of each grade level. Student placement will be based on the availability of the teaching staff in each location, and the academic needs of each student.

We may need to limit the number of students who can participate in this opportunity, so please contact the school as soon as possible to reserve your child's place in the summer program.

This program will NOT replace the Extended School Year (ESY) that is available to students with individualized educational plans. Enrollment is open to students looking to further their learning in the areas of reading and math.

Summer school credit recovery will be offered to students in grades 9-12 at Havre High School. Additional information for high school students will be available from the High School.

In summary, what we need to know from you as parents/guardians:

- The name and current grade of your child/children who will be participating.
- Whether you will need transportation from Havre Public Schools.
- If you will commit to a four week program, four days per week, three hours per day.
- Notify your current school/Principal by Friday, May 21
