

Governor Bullock announced on Tuesday that school closures have been extended through April 10. School districts were instructed last week to create plans, in the event of future closures, for providing (1) education through remote learning, where possible, (2) school meal services, where possible, (3) services for students with disabilities, and (4) other services customarily provided to children in school.

Following approval of the district's remote learning plan at the special board meeting Thursday, March 26, we will be engaging in remote learning through April 10, in accordance with the Governor's message and guidance from the Office of Public Instruction. If a continuation of the closure of school occurs, the district will revisit the remote learning plan and will look to students, parents, and teachers for feedback on how to improve this process.
