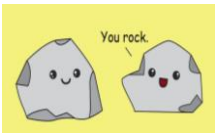

## 10 Test Taking TIPS



1. Get 9-11 hours of sleep the night before a test. (Actually, you should be sleeping that much EVERY night!)
2. Eat a healthy breakfast in the morning and drink plenty of water! (Drinking H<sub>2</sub>O calms your nerves & helps you to focus.) EAT THIS OR THIS NOT THAT
3. Arrive to school on time. (So you don't feel rushed or miss anything)
4. Have a positive attitude and motto.
5. Read all the directions and answer choices carefully before you pick the best answer. (Be a test detective and look for important word clues like, "true, false, always, or never.")
6. ~~Cross out~~ and eliminate the answer choices you know are incorrect ( or just plain silly).
7. Don't get stuck on the more challenging questions. Skip, move on, and return to them at the end. (This will help reduce feelings of frustration & help you to pace yourself)
8. Do a quick and quiet brain break if you notice you are starting to lose your focus. (Rub your temples, give yourself a hug or arm massage, tap your head, stretch your fingers, take a few mindful breaths, or push your palms together)
9. Review and check your work after you have answered all of the questions. (Don't leave any question blank.)
10. AND ALWAYS REMEMBER THIS:  
A test cannot measure your worthiness, lovability, kindness, empathy, curiosity, passions, creativity, or courage.
