Check & Connect

Check and Connect is an intervention used with K-12 students who show warning signs of disengagement with school and who are dropping out. At the core of Check & Connect is a trusting relationship between a student and a caring, trained mentor who both advocates for and challenges the student to keep education salient. Students are referred to Check & Connect when they show the warning signs of disengaging from school, such as poor attendance, behavior issues, and/or low grades. In Check & Connect, the “check” component refers to the process where mentors systematically monitor student performance variables (i.e. absences, tardies, behavioral referrals, grades), while the “connect” component refers to mentors providing personalized, timely interventions to help students solve problems, build skills, and enhance competence. Mentors work with caseloads of students and families for at least two years, functioning as liaisons between home and school and striving to build constructive family-school relationships.

Peggy Perry and Marilyn Granell are retired teachers and MTSS Implementation Specialists. They were trained in Check & Connect at the University of Minnesota and presented Check & Connect trainings throughout Montana last year and at the MBI Summer Institute.
