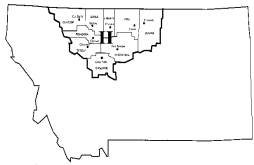


COMPREHENSIVE SYSTEM OF PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT

Mandt System Training

The Mandt System builds on skill development through a system of gradual and graded alternatives for deescalating and assisting people using a combination of interpersonal communication skills, conflict resolution strategies and physical interaction techniques.

The goal is to assist others in managing themselves and the safety of all involved through skillful and nonphysical means. Physical strategies are also taught to provide additional “least restrictive” options in the event the person poses a clear threat of substantial harm to self or others if physically unassisted.

This training is limited to 20 attendees.

The focus of The Mandt System is primarily on prevention.
